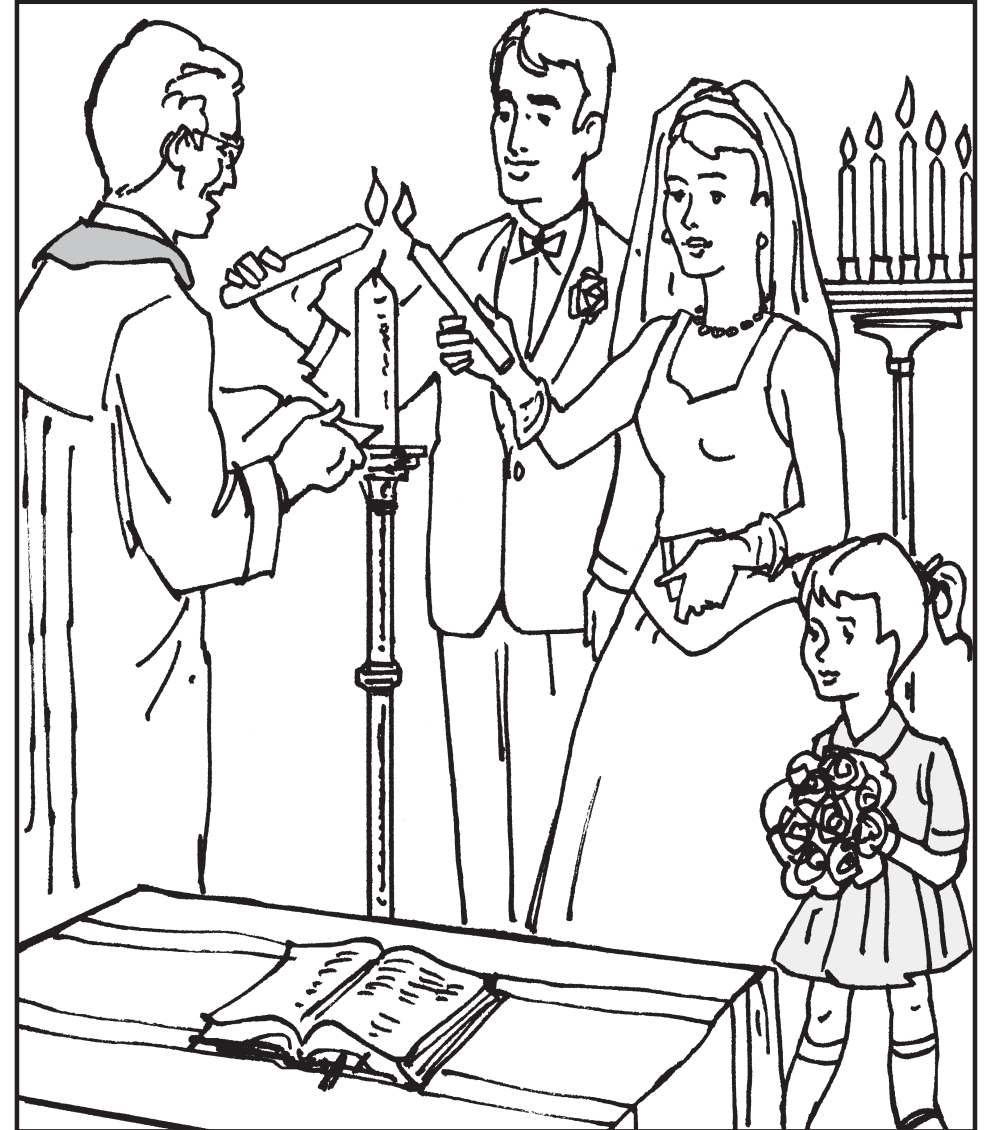

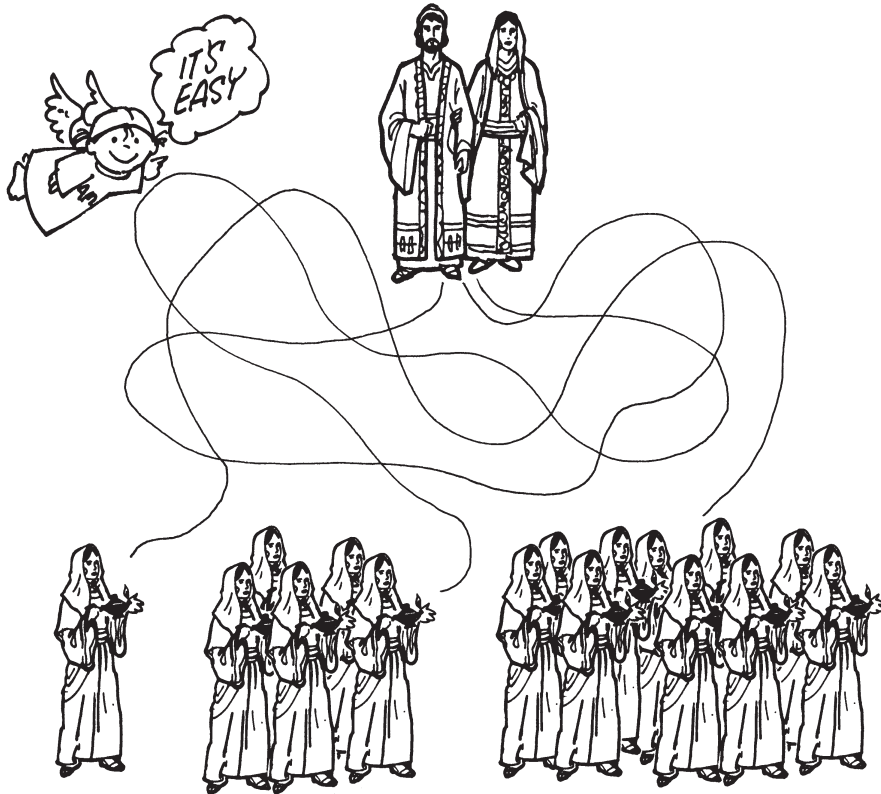
Do You Remember?
